We are required to monitor your drinking water on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. Between 4/1/2021 and 6/30/2021, we failed to submit the required samples as indicated below and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

The samples were collected. However, the bottles and chain of custody for the samples were filled out incorrectly with the wrong sample location. We will continue monitoring the HAAS on our next round of samples in August 2021 and November 2021
