Our water system violated State drinking water requirement. Even though these were not emergencies, you, as our customers, have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct the situation (See table below).

An on-site evaluation of our system is conducted on a regular basis. Results of the evaluation show significant deficiencies in our water system which must be addressed to the Office of Environmental Health Services- District Office. We did not correct these deficiencies by the required date and are therefore in violation.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

Failure to correct significant deficiencies	Within 120 days of written notification

What happened? What is being done? (Describe corrective action)

The Coalwood WTP had some significant deficiencies and some required additional funding to get these resolved. In awaiting the funding, our 120 days grace period ran out. The problems have since been resolved and new equipment has been installed.
